



USING STEPS VS. TEMPLATES

Step by step guides

We recommend these be the first option to try when preparing a lesson. Project steps for students to follow as you guide them through each step during a folding session.

TIP: Encourage students to touch the particular edges of planes where you are indicating are to be folded, this helps student follow along.

A4 folding templates

Use A4 templates to verify stepped folds are correct and proportions accurate if needed ahead of class.

Templates are also commonly used to send to students who may have missed a class so they can catch up.

Some students find A4 templates easier than step guides. After these students use the template, encourage them to take a new blank sheet of paper to replicate.

In some cases it may help to reverse engineer the template so they can refold their blank sheet and old template, side by side.
